

# SHIPPING TO HAWAII



There might be an ocean separating our trucks from Hawaii, but that doesn't prevent us from getting your freight there on-time and claims-free. Below are the steps we take to safely and securely deliver your shipment from the U.S. mainland to wherever it needs to go in the 50th state.



1.

Customer creates a shipment and schedules a pickup of their freight through Saia's web portal.



2.

Customer's freight is picked up and delivered to the local origin terminal.



3.

Freight is sent by linehaul to the Saia terminal in **Orange, CA.**



4.

Freight is consolidated and delivered to Royal Hawaiian Express (RHE) location in Long Beach, CA.



5.

RHE loads Hawaiian bound freight onto trailers and containers prepared for maritime shipment.

6.

Container ships departing Long Beach for Honolulu are shipped on a twice weekly for the 2,553 mile journey.

7.

Wednesday departures arrive in Honolulu the following Tuesday and Saturday departures arrive the following Thursday.



8.

**4 days**

Once freight lands in Honolulu, freight destined for other islands is delivered within four days or less.

9.

**1-3 days**

One additional day is required to ship to Kauai and Maui. Three additional days is required to ship to the "Big Island" of Hawaii.

Customers can receive full tracking and reporting information of their shipment through Saia's web portal, from pickup to final delivery.

Once freight has landed at its final port, trailers are taken off the boat for final delivery by RHE.
